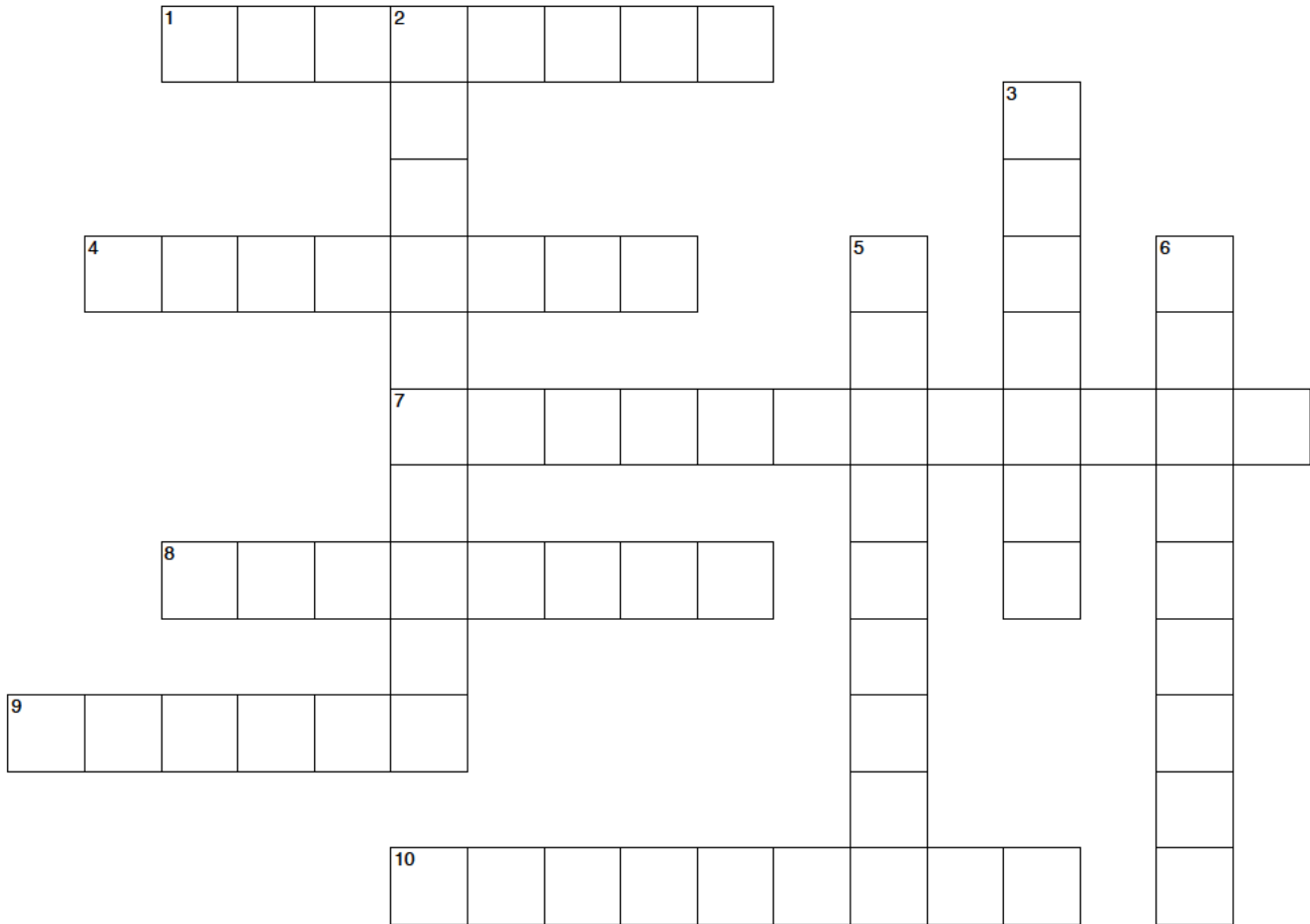


Dreaming

ACROSS

- 1 acting with or having good reason or sense
- 4 likely to be or likely to happen
- 7 the things you think or assume will happen in the future
- 8 made the original plans for something
- 9 strong hopes or goals
- 10 useful to what is really happening

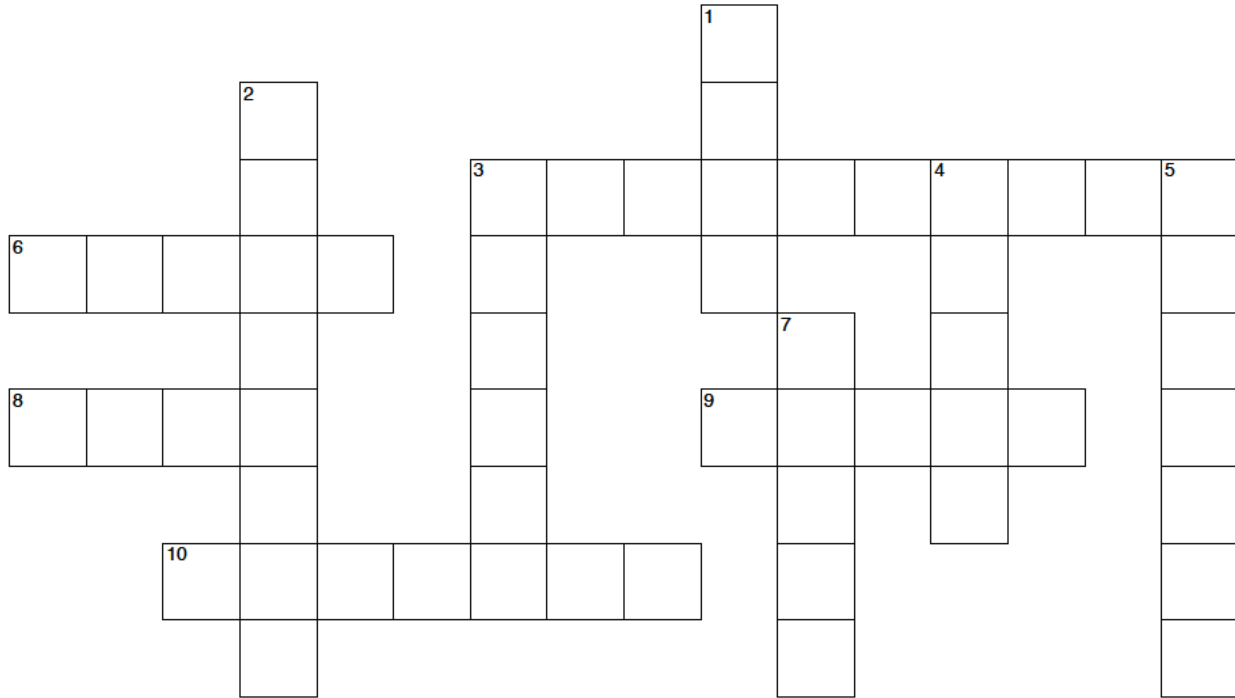
DOWN

- 2 plans for what to do and how to act
- 3 when a person says he or she will be sure to do something or that certain things are sure to happen
- 5 seeing things the way they really are and not pretending something else will happen
- 6 to spend time thinking about things that are not real or not likely to happen

- 10 bothered or angered

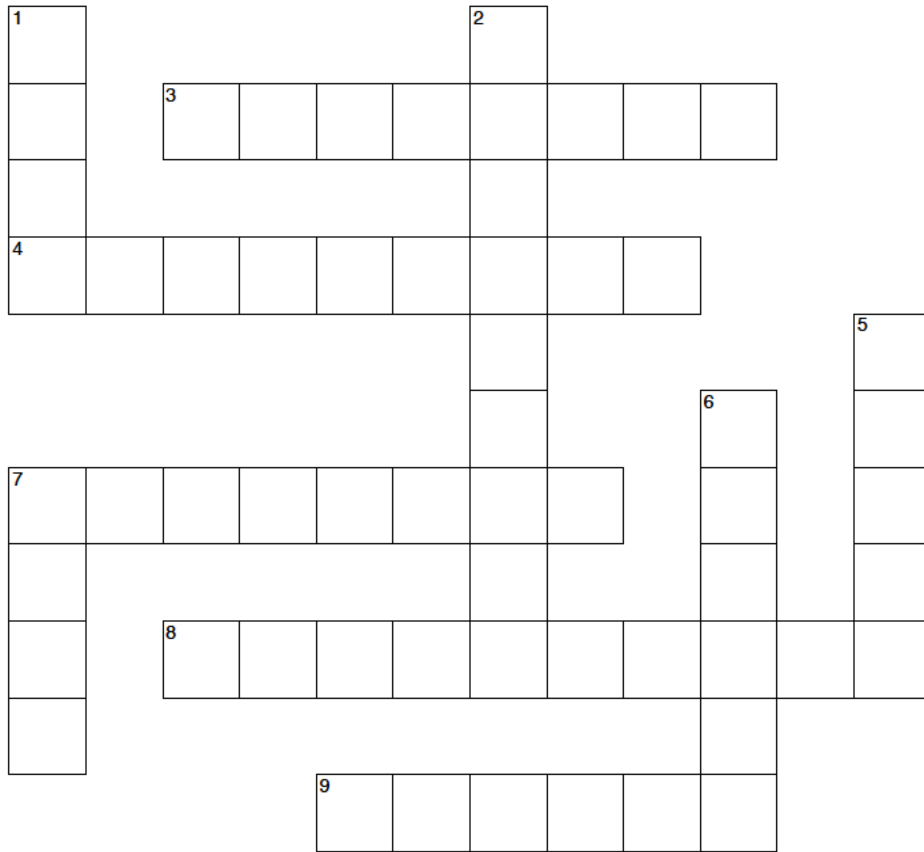
DOWN

- 1 all the others or the other parts of something
- 2 trying to get something by acting in a way that is not fair or does not follow the rules
- 3 in a way that is right or follows the rules
- 4 feeling mad
- 5 chose or made up one's mind
- 7 passed or used up a certain amount of time

WORD BANK: angry, annoyed, apart, cheating, decided, fairly, foot, frustrated, rest, spent, upset

ACROSS

- 3 to think about something that happened or that you knew at an earlier time
- 4 pieces of the hard outer layer covering an egg, especially after an egg is hatched or cracked open
- 7 used something that belongs to someone else
- 8 something you receive when you do something wrong
- 9 very serious or not allowing people to break the rules

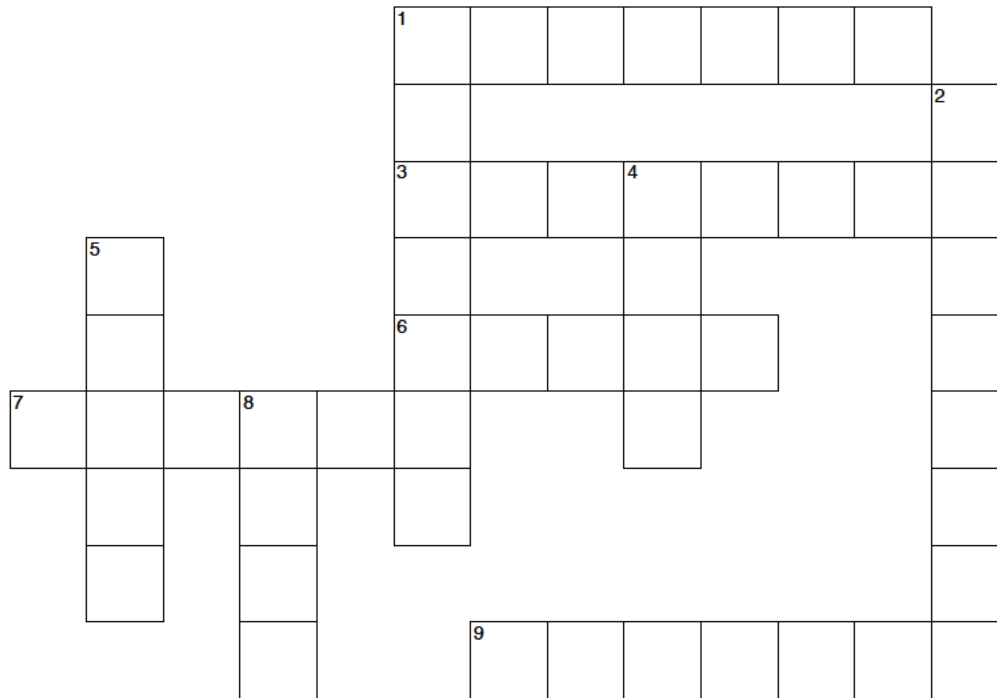
DOWN

- 1 to take on something difficult
- 2 the people who work for a person or a company and are paid for their work
- 5 to make someone mad, sad, or hurt
- 6 to take what is offered or given to you
- 7 a person who is in charge of someone at a job and makes decisions

WORD BANK: accept, borrowed, boss, eggshells, employees, face, punishment, remember, strict, upset

ACROSS

- 1 something that is difficult to deal with
- 3 ending a fight by agreeing on some things
- 6 a group of words that may not mean what it sounds like
- 7 a tool that can be used to fight or hunt
- 9 covering something so that it cannot be seen or used

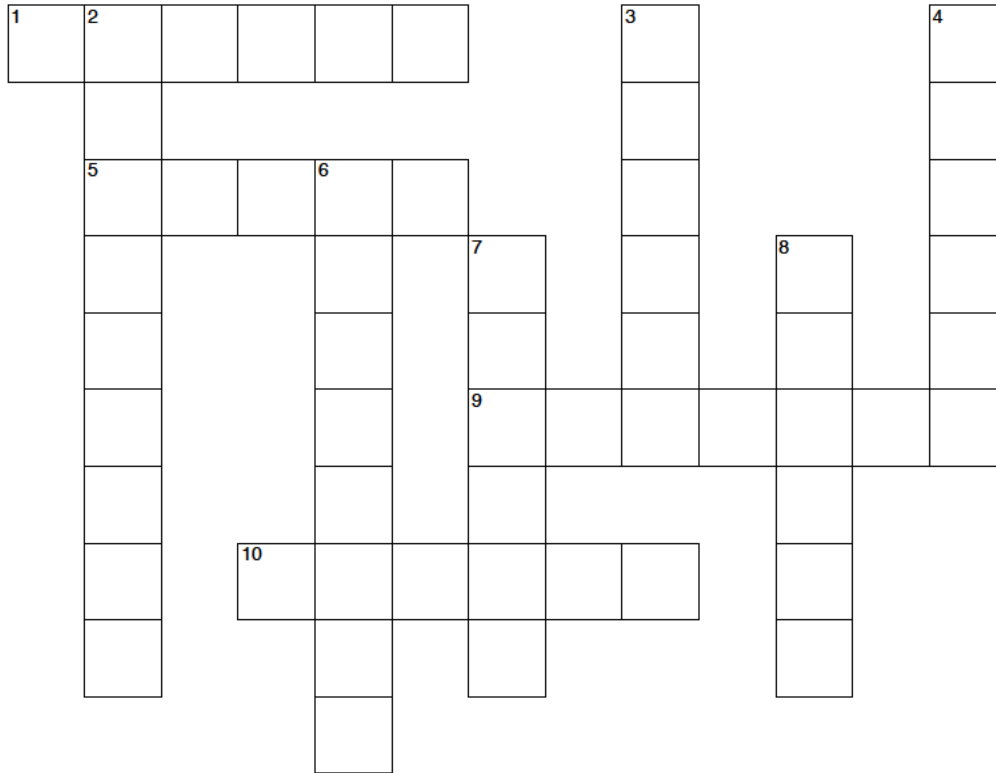
DOWN

- 1 moving by or moving on
- 2 thinking the same thing is true as someone else
- 4 something that is made or shaped to help you do work
- 5 to spend a lot of time thinking about something or to pay a lot of attention to something
- 8 the time before now

Out of Money

ACROSS

- 1 the cause of something that happens
- 5 to hold or squeeze tightly
- 9 no longer working
- 10 to change into

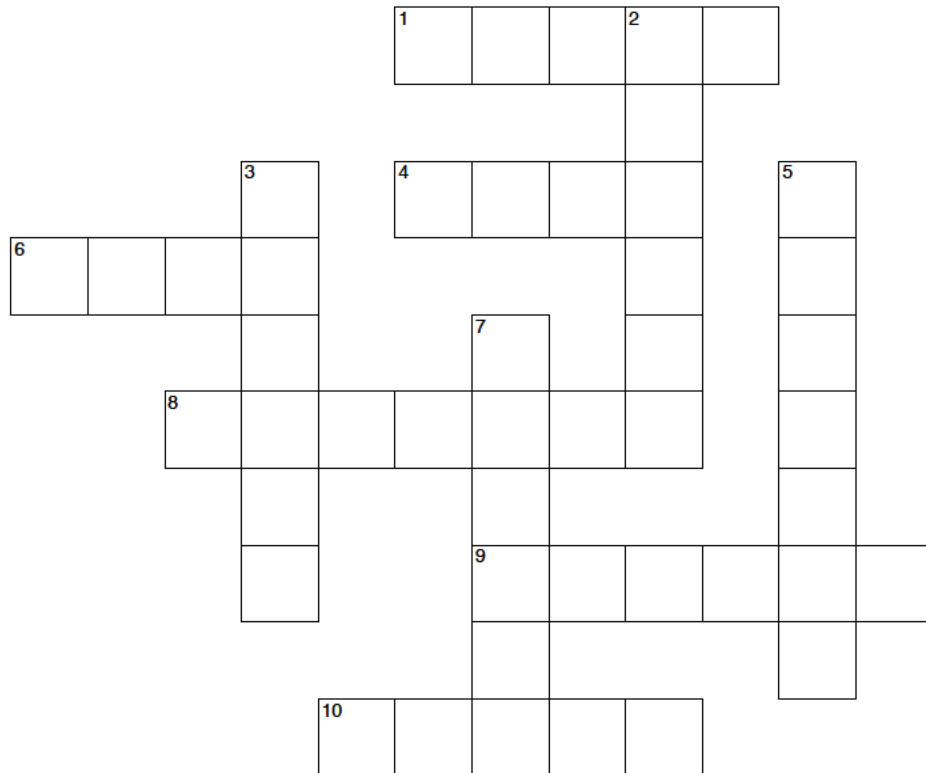
DOWN

- 2 costing a lot of money
- 3 how much you can spend or how much you want to spend on a certain thing
- 4 to have the money to pay for something
- 6 costing the least amount of money
- 7 to use something that belongs to someone else
- 8 hardly ever or not often

WORD BANK: afford, become, borrow, budget, cheapest, expensive, pinch, rarely, reason, retired

ACROSS

- 1 to act or behave toward someone in a certain way
- 4 to make something known or to let people see
- 6 a planned meeting between two people
- 8 well-known phrases that people use to describe certain situations
- 9 hurtful, not nice
- 10 many times

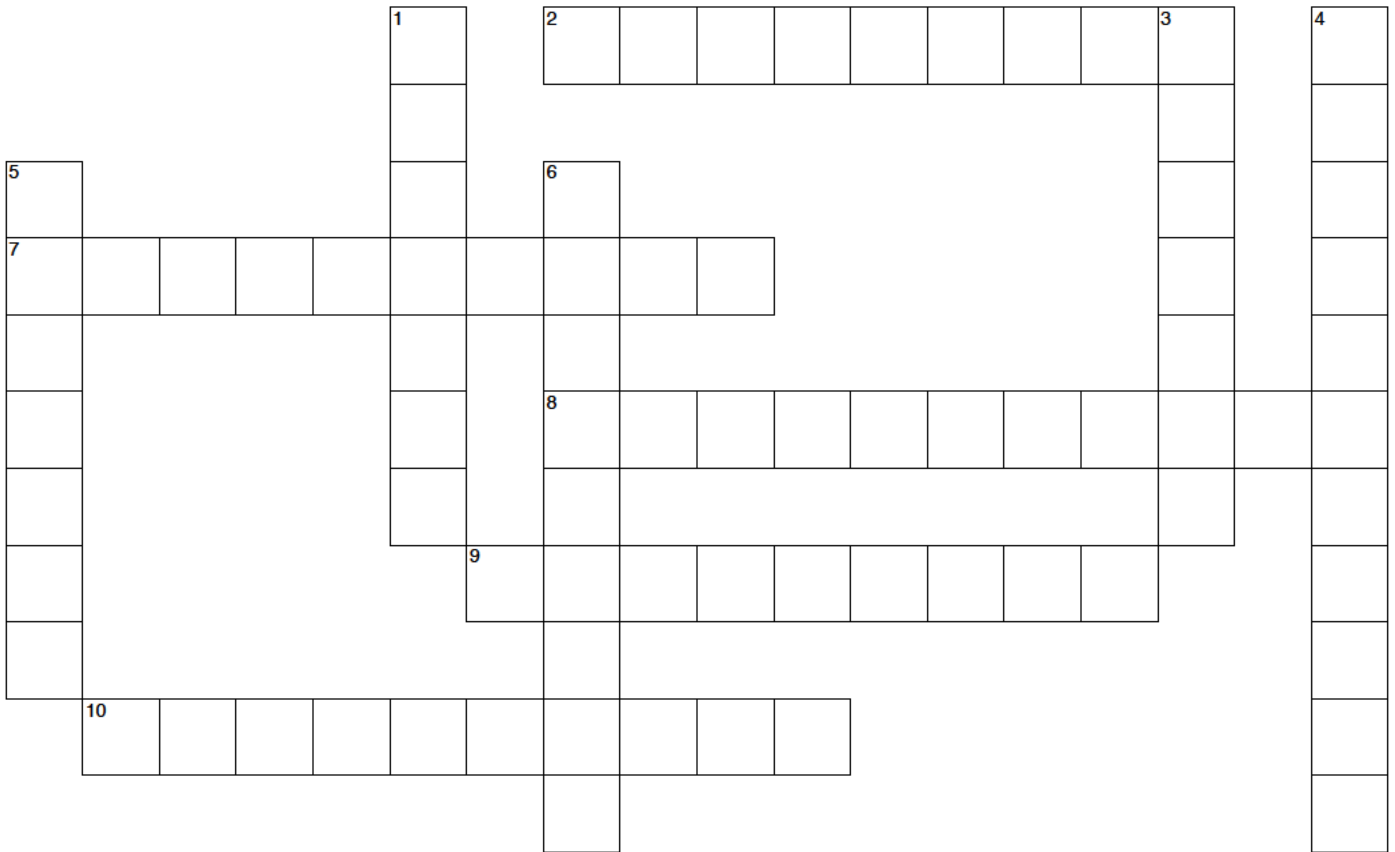
DOWN

- 2 all the time
- 3 to act a certain way
- 5 the things a person does
- 7 to say or do something that makes a person feel bad

WORD BANK: actions, always, behave, date, insult, often, sayings, show, treat, unkind

ACROSS

- 2 people who buy things
- 7 started or came to be
- 8 all the things, feelings, and people that surround you
- 9 very difficult or full of pressure
- 10 more or extra

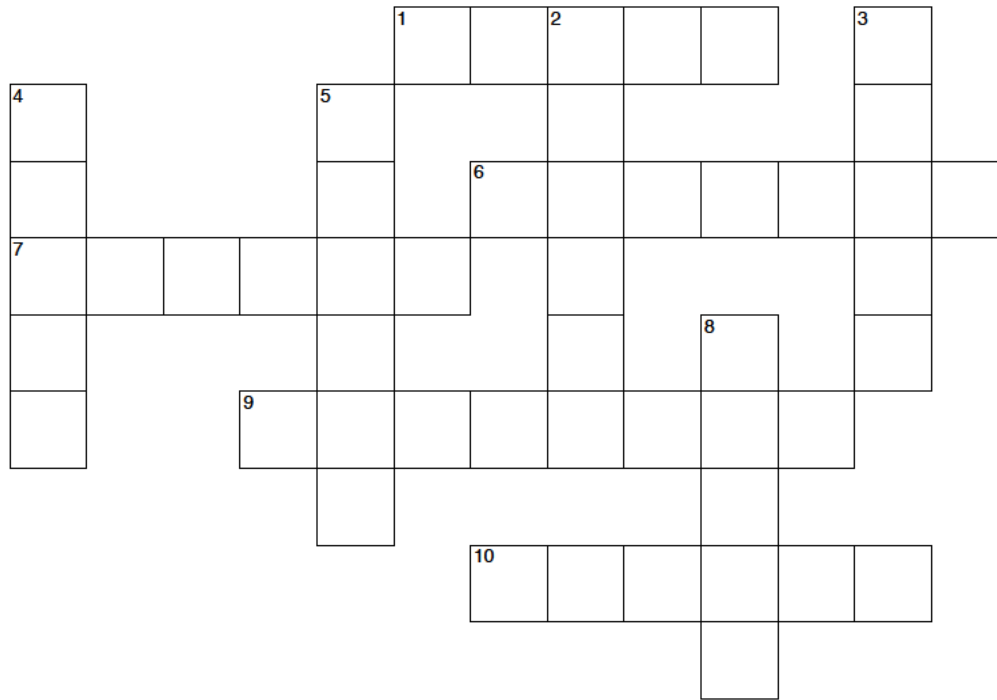
DOWN

- 1 the land outside a city or town
- 3 did not go to something
- 4 trying to do better than others
- 5 a group of people who work together to make or sell products
- 6 the act of keeping one's mind on a particular thing

WORD BANK: additional, attention, company, competitive, country, customers, environment, originated, skipped, stressful

Time to Speak

ACROSS

- 1 a person's thoughts or plans
- 6 what a person thinks about something
- 7 to hurt someone's feelings or to make someone feel angry or upset
- 9 when people vote to choose someone for a job
- 10 ideas or thoughts about what someone could do in a certain situation

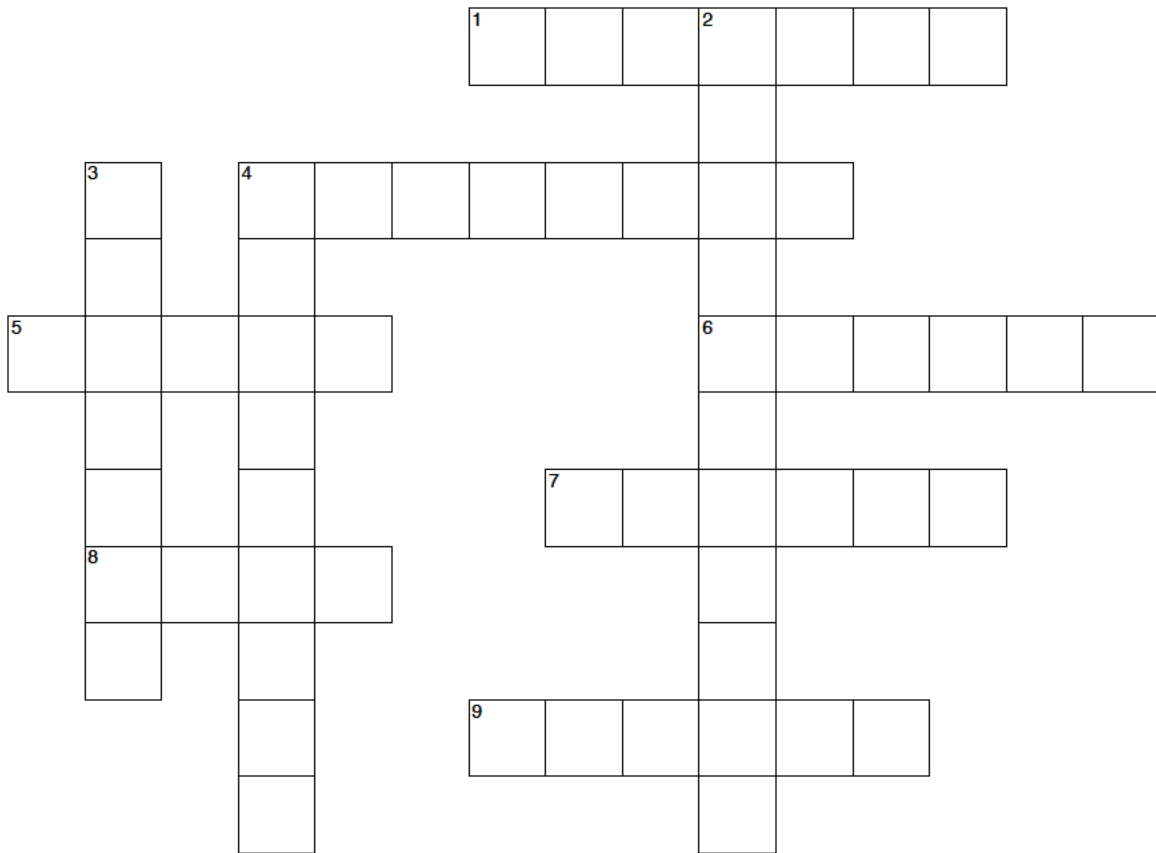
DOWN

- 2 to think a certain thing will probably happen
- 3 to tell a person that he or she has done something wrong
- 4 more than one or two of something
- 5 kind, mild, or easy
- 8 something people talk, think, or write about

WORD BANK: advice, election, expect, gentle, group, ideas, offend, opinion, scold, topic

Too Much Money!

ACROSS

- 1 how much of something you have
- 4 guessing what will happen in a game or event and betting money that you are right
- 5 to use too much of something or to use something in a careless way
- 6 having a high price or costing a lot of money
- 7 in a way that is smart or using good sense
- 8 to work in order to get something you want or need
- 9 in a way that is not good

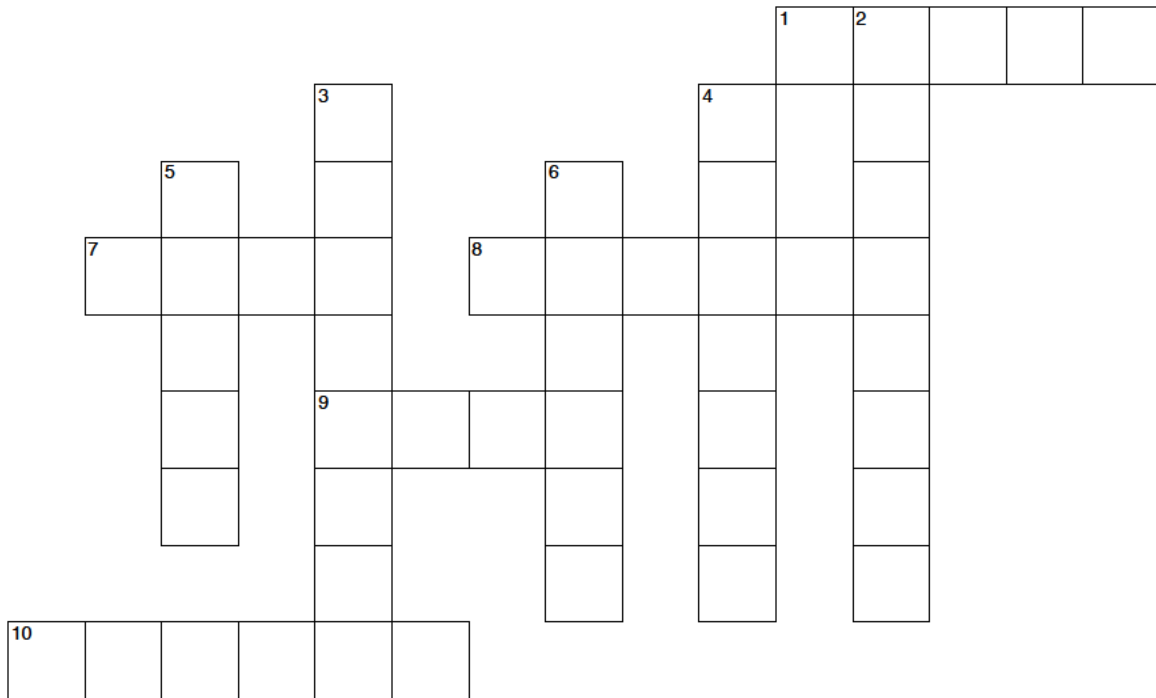
DOWN

- 2 not needed
- 3 thought about and decided how to do something before it happened
- 4 bringing together in one place

WORD BANK: amounts, costly, earn, gambling, gathering, planned, poorly, unnecessary, waste, wisely

Tough Times

Idioms, Level 3.5



ACROSS

- 1 forward
- 7 a person who is in charge of someone at a job and makes decisions
- 8 a group of words that has a meaning but does not make a sentence
- 9 a chance or time to do something
- 10 in back of

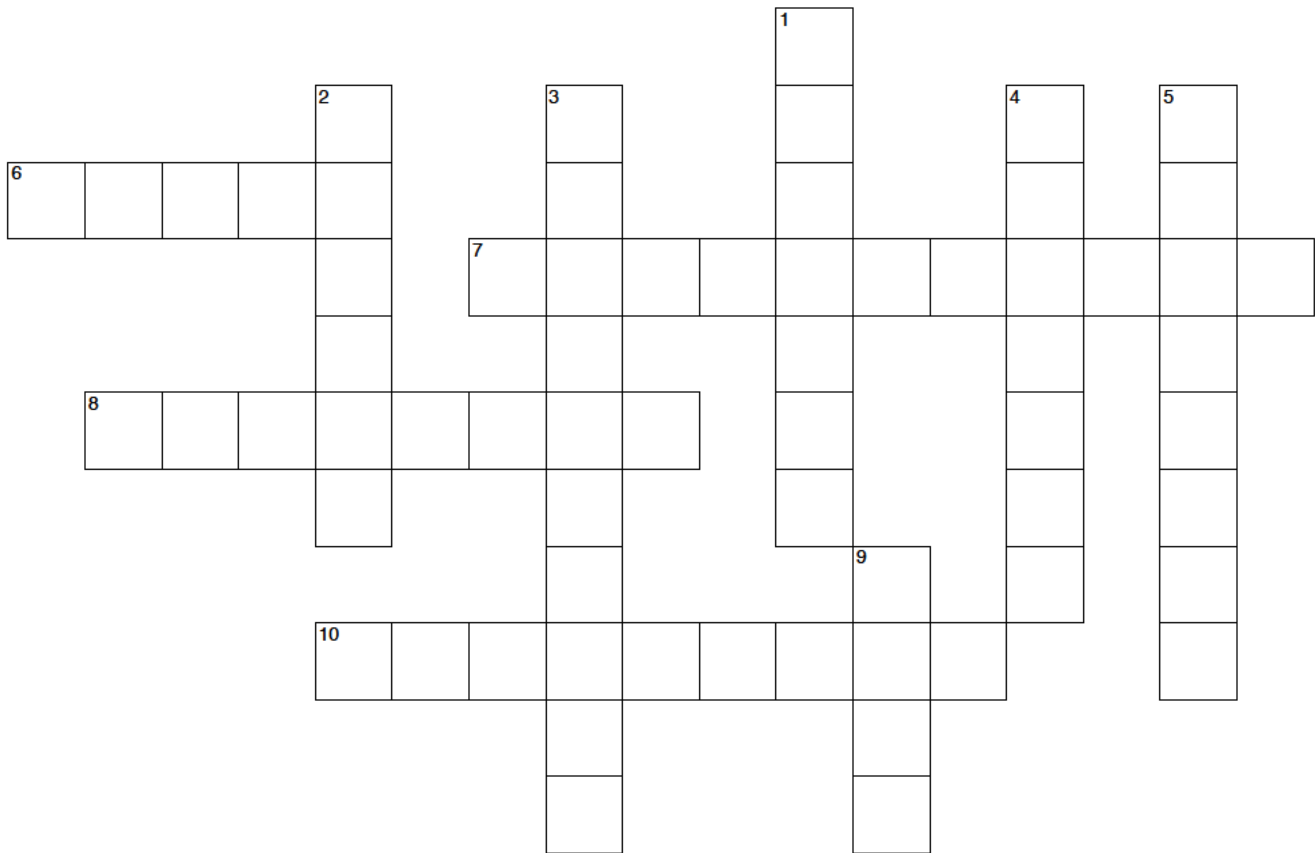
DOWN

- 2 extra work given by a teacher to be done outside of school
- 3 a place where a person or thing is
- 4 a pair of lenses, special pieces of glass or plastic, in a frame used to help someone see more clearly
- 5 more harmful or more unpleasant
- 6 to make something different from the way it was before

- 10 the way something goes or the path along which something moves

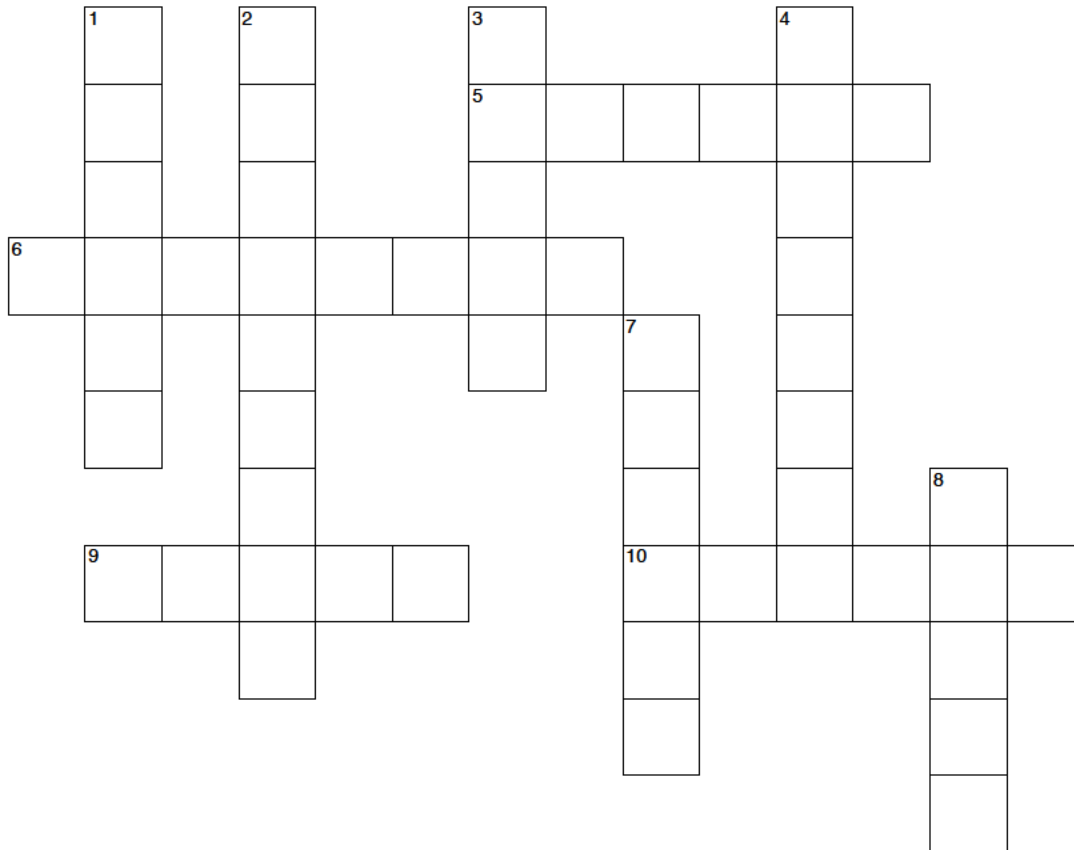
DOWN

- 3 totally or in all ways
- 4 the small parts that make up something
- 5 likely to be or likely to happen
- 9 to trick someone or to make a person believe something that is not true

WORD BANK: actually, believe, completely, details, direction, fool, grain, imagination, probably, untrue

- 6 someone who collects information and tells it to people
- 9 types
- 10 people who are elected to be the leaders of governments in towns or cities

DOWN

- 1 to make a change in something
- 2 useful or valuable
- 3 the ability to make decisions or to tell others what to do
- 4 really, truly, or in fact
- 7 correct for an official or serious occasion
- 8 parts of a place that have a special use
