


Atlantis—Found?

- 10 an old story that may or may not be true


DOWN

- 6** a person or persons belonging to the king's or queen's family


DOWN

- 8 surrounded by or in the middle of something


DOWN



- 10 thick and sticky


DOWN

- 7** straps, pieces of metal, or other things that keep someone from moving easily or getting away


DOWN





- 10 to stay in the air in one place


DOWN

- 10** to form little pockets of air or gas



- 9 a custom or way of doing something as it has been done in the past


DOWN



- 10 to be real or alive


DOWN



- 7 saved from danger or harm


DOWN

- 9 led or showed the way


DOWN



- 10 the ability to do something well



- 9 not grown


DOWN

- 10 a dead body that has been kept from rotting


DOWN
