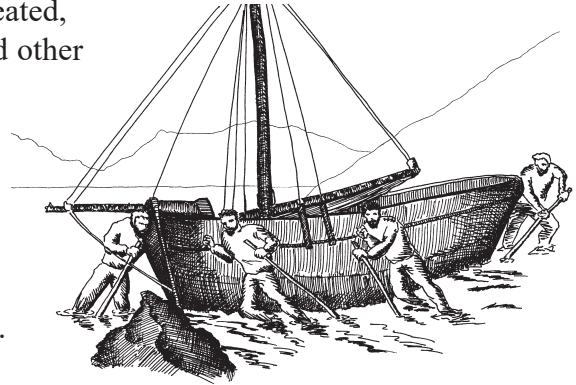


Courage, Skill, and Teamwork

Read the Story²⁻⁴

7 In 1864, a ship named the *Grafton*
 13 **wrecked** near Auckland Island. All five
 19 sailors safely reached shore, but their
 23 troubles had only begun.
 28 They were trapped between Antarctica
 34 and New Zealand, 285 miles from
 39 **civilization**, surrounded by **rough** seas.
 46 The island was a **miserable refuge**. There
 55 was little to eat and little **relief** from the
 62 **harsh** winds and freezing rain. To **survive**,
 68 the men had to work together.
 73 They constructed a cabin using
 81 materials from the island and wreck; for the
 87 chimney, they mixed cement using ashes
 94 and sand. They made their own clothes,
 102 soap, and ink. They kept their minds busy,
 107 teaching each other different languages
 114 and skills like reading and writing. A
 year passed, and they began to lose hope.

122 Would nobody come for them? Might they
 129 be stuck there forever?
 133 The men knew they could build a
 140 strong boat with the right tools—they just
 148 needed a **forge** to make these tools. They
 156 worked hard for six months, building a
 163 forge, **crafting** tools, and then constructing
 169 a small boat that could carry three men. If
 178 the three men reached safety, they would
 185 send help for the other two. It was finally
 194 time to **brave** the seas.
 199 Hours after the men **set sail**, the winds
 207 **whipped** into a **hurricane**. Giant waves
 213 crashed over the little boat but didn't sink
 221 it. Stormy weather continued, but after six
 228 days, the three men reached land! In the
 236 end, all five sailors arrived safely home.
 243 Their **courage**, skill, and **teamwork** had
 249 saved them.
