

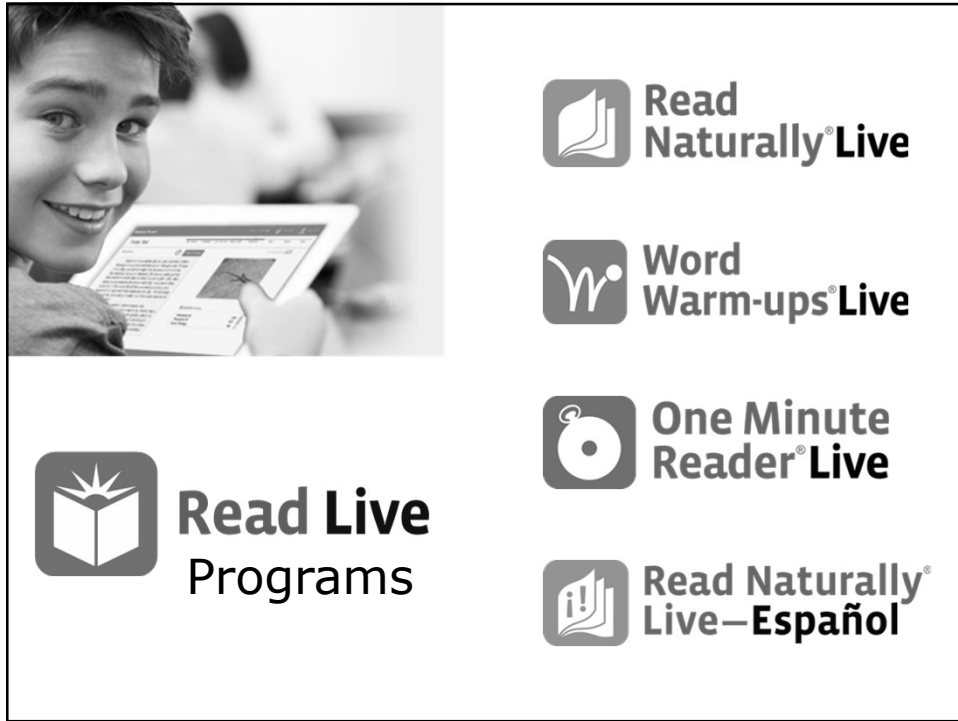

Spanish-language Literacy Skills

Beneficial for developing reading skills...



- In Spanish before (or while) developing reading skills in the English
- For multilingual students or students in dual-language programs
- When students are learning Spanish as an additional language

- Vocabulary
- Fluency
- Comprehension



What is reading fluency?

Fluent readers are able to read orally with:



- Appropriate speed
- Accuracy
- Proper expression

Oral reading fluency correlates highly with reading comprehension.

Measure	Validity Coefficients
Oral Recall/Retelling	.70
Cloze (fill in the blank)	.72
Question Answering	.82
Oral Reading Fluency	.91

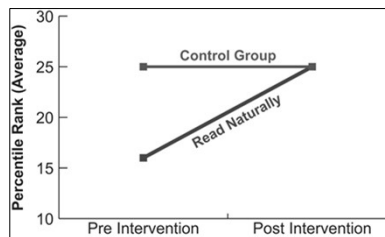
The Original Results

The table below shows the mean number of words read correctly per minute and average number of words gained per week for third-grade students.

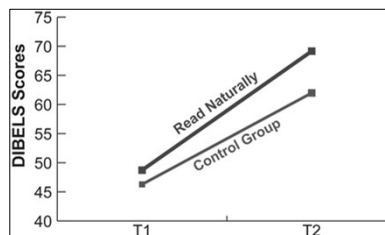

Use el reloj para medir el tiempo mientras lee la lectura y luego vea la gráfica.



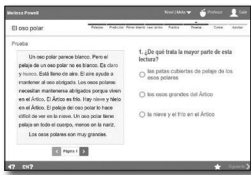
5. Leer Juntos

Lea la lectura a su profesor y luego vean los resultados juntos.



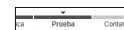
Abrir Read Naturally Live—Español

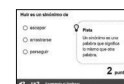

Options for students working to develop Spanish and English reading skills:

- Work in Read Naturally Live, Word Warm-ups Live, or One Minute Reader Live (English-language programs) for the first 10 minutes of the session, then switch to Read Naturally Live—Español.
- Use the first half of the session for Read Naturally Live—Español, then switch to another assigned program for the remainder of the session.
- Alternate between assigned programs after completing each pass activity.
